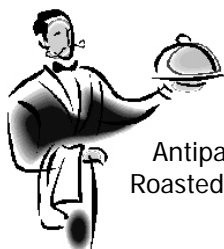

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Veteran Dogs - For dogs 7 years and older. The winner of this class is eligible for the Best of Breed Competition.

Veteran Bitches - For bitches 7 years and older. The winner of this class is eligible for the Best of Breed Competition.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

As the judge's decision in the following classes is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won in these classes.

The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with the get or produce and be entered in the stud dog or brood bitch class, but need not be entered in any regular class. The owner of the stud dog or brood bitch does not need to be the owner of the get or produce.

Stud Dog Class - For dogs that have sired two or more dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award is based on the merits of the get. No more than four of his get shall exhibit with the Stud Dog. A castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in this class.

Brood Bitch Class - For Brood Bitches that have whelped at least two or more dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award is based on the merits of the produce; no more than four of her produce shall exhibit with the brood bitch. A spayed bitch may be entered as a brood bitch in this class.

Futurity & Maturity

The entry process for Futurity & Maturity involves submitting three different nomination forms, each of which is due at a specific time. All puppies must have been nominated by their breeder(s), although they may have a different owner at the time of the show.

AIR TRAVEL

There are 3 full service Airports in the area within 50 miles of the Hotel and show site. San Francisco - 42 miles, San Jose - 30 miles, and Oakland - 25 miles. This is a major metropolitan area, so be sure to allow plenty of time for traffic.

DIRECTIONS TO HOTEL

-From the East or West, take interstate 580 East, exit Hopyard Rd, South on Hopyard, hotel will be 2 blocks South on the left side

-From the North or South, take interstate 680 South, merge onto 580 East, exit Hopyard Rd, head South on hopyard, hotel will be 2 blocks south on left side

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

From Hwy. 680 North or Southbound in the Pleasanton Area take the Bernal Ave. exit. Go East on Bernal and make left at first traffic light onto Valley Ave. Enter through Gate 12

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE FROM THE HOTEL

Go South on Hopyard toward Gibraltar Dr. Go 1.6 miles. Turn Right on Valley. Go 1.1 mile. Gate 12 will be on your left.

Unloading Sunday and Monday is through **both** the Main Gate off Pleasanton Avenue and Gate 12 off Valley Avenue. Any exhibitor may drive onto the grounds to unload between 6:00 AM and 7:15 AM. All vehicles must be off the grounds by 7:30 AM or they will be towed. Be sure to allow yourself plenty of time as this cannot be extended for safety reasons. Except for medical emergencies, no vehicles may drive onto the show grounds after 7:15 AM. You may drive back in to load up only after all judging in your area has concluded. After 7:15 AM an unloading loop will be open all day between the Young California and Exhibition Buildings and through the tunnel in the back for the North Forty rings.

Dog Washing on the Fairgrounds

The 1996 Clean Water Act is now being enforced at the Alameda County Fairgrounds. All gray water (which includes soapy water from washing dogs) must be discharged into sanitary sewer systems only and not dumped onto the ground or into storm drains. A hefty fine can be leveled against offenders. Del Valle will be placing Dog Bathtubs around the grounds for your convenience. Please check the Fairgrounds map in the Judging Program for designated dog washing locations. We will do our best to make it easy for all of you.

Grooming & Set-Ups

Ample grooming space will be available in the building adjacent to our ring. No Ex-pens are allowed in buildings. Buildings will be locked from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM overnight.

Clean-up is Your Responsibility

Pooper-scoopers (in chlorine filled buckets) will be placed all around the grounds and outside all rings. If your dog soils the parking lot, show grounds or ring, it is your responsibility to clean it up. By signing the entry form at this show you are agreeing that all clean-up is your responsibility. Violators may be subject to an event show committee hearing. Thank you for your cooperation.

PCA ROOM RESPONSIBILITY POLICY

PCA has adopted the following rules in order to insure that the members and their dogs will be welcome at hotels in the future. Any individual attending a PCA Sanctioned Event and staying in a hotel, motel, inn or campsite/fairground has the responsibility of leaving that room or campsite exactly as found. This includes picking up after dogs on the grounds. Anyone who damages a room or campsite/fairgrounds and does not report the damage to the hotel/campsite/fairground management and make immediate restitution or arrangements to do so within a period of time agreed upon by the management, will be subject to any or all the following actions by the PCA Board of Directors. 1. May be banned from showing at the next PCA sanctioned event(s). 2. May be subject to AKC sanctions. 3. Membership in PCA may be terminated and may not be allowed to be reinstated. DAMAGES SHALL BE DEFINED AS: 1. Flea infestation, urine, defecation and/or any damage to hotel/campsite/fairground property (walls, bedspreads, carpets, drapes, etc.). 2. Any verified complaint by the host hotel/campsite/fairground. 3. Any verified complaint by a PCA member. PCA ROOM REGULATIONS: 1. All dogs must be crated and quiet when left alone in a room. Noisy dogs shall be quieted upon request, even if this means the owner/handler must stay in the room with the dog. 2. Individuals will be expected to immediately report any damage by dogs or themselves to the hotel/campsite/fairground management and to assume complete financial responsibility for those damages. 3. No bathing or grooming will be allowed in the rooms. A grooming room will be available whenever possible. 4. Dogs are to be allowed on furniture ONLY if the furniture is covered with protective covering provided by the owner/handler. 5. All owner/handlers will take preventative measures to assure that their dogs are free of fleas, mites, intestinal parasites and other communicable diseases prior to arriving at the hotel/campsite.
